Call to Worship: *Hebrews 10:19-21*

The Lord Jesus, by his perfect obedience, and sacrifice of himself, which he, through the eternal Spirit, once offered up unto God, has fully satisfied the justice of his Father; and purchased, not only reconciliation, but an everlasting inheritance in the kingdom of heaven, for all those whom the Father hath given unto him. Although the work of redemption was not actually finished by Christ till after his incarnation, yet the virtue, efficacy, and benefits thereof were applied to the elect, in all ages successively from the beginning of the world, in and by those promises, types, and sacrifices, wherein he was revealed, and signified to be the seed of the woman which should bruise the serpent's head; and the Lamb slain from the beginning of the world; being yesterday and today the same, and forever.

Questions to prepare for Next week: What is the similarity and difference between “stirring up” a disagreement (Acts 15:39) and stirring up to love and good works (Hebrews 10:24)? Both texts use the same Greek word! Think of times when something you have said or done had the opposite impact from what you had hoped. Why might that have happened?
