### Preparation for Worship: *I John 1:1*

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we looked upon and have touched with our hands, concerning the word of life—the life was made manifest, and we have seen it, and testify to it and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was made manifest to us.

### Call to Worship: *I John 1:3.4*

That which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. And we are writing these things so that our joy may be complete.

### Confession of Sin:

Lord God of all light, we confess that we have walked in darkness rather than your light. We believe that we are in fellowship with you even while we walk in darkness. We confess that our fellowship with each other is mostly limited to what is convenient and makes us feel good. Our fellowship has not caused us to be washed in the sacrificial blood of Christ that cleanses us. We agree with your word that condemns both our practices and our failure to practice your truth. Lord Jesus Christ forgive our presumption, and our intentional transgressions. Holy Spirit forgive our wandering hearts and wills. Draw them back to yourself.

**Assurance of Pardon: 1 John 2:1**

My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

**Westminster Confession of Faith: Chapter 9.3,4**

Man, by his fall into a state of sin, has wholly lost all ability to will to or choose any spiritual good accompanying salvation. So as a natural man, being altogether averse from that good, and dead in sin, is not able, by his own strength, to convert himself, or to prepare himself for salvation.

When God converts a sinner and translates Him into the state of grace, He frees him from his natural bondage under sin, and, by His grace alone, enables him freely to will and to do that which is spiritually good. But because of his remaining corruption, he does not perfectly, or only, choose that which is good, but also chooses that which is evil.
