Since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe.

Call to Worship: Hebrews: 12:18, 22-24

You have not come to a mountain that can be touched and that is burning with fire; to darkness, gloom and storm; to a trumpet blast or to such a voice speaking words that those who heard it begged that no further word be spoken to them. But you have come to Mount Zion, to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem. You have come to thousands upon thousands of angels in joyful assembly, to the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven. You have come to God, the Judge of all, to the spirits of the righteous made perfect, to Jesus the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel.

Confession of Sin

Heavenly Father you have laid our sorrow and our sin on Jesus who was crucified for us as a reject on the outside of the city. You have called us to minister his grace in the city, but we judge the city and the evil around us rather than weeping for it. We fear being rejected and so we reject others and their needs as well as their behavior. Our sin is our failure to believe, our failure to encourage others to know you, and our failure to intercede as Jesus intercedes for us. Holy Spirit, work in us that we might become your hands and voice to the suffering of the world.

Assurance of Pardon: Hebrews 13:12-15

And so Jesus also suffered outside the city gate to make the people holy through his own blood. Let us, then, go to him outside the camp, bearing the disgrace he bore. For here we do not have an enduring city, but we are looking for the city that is to come. Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise – the fruit of lips that openly profess his name.
