Confession of Sin

Almighty, creator and sustaining God, we cannot take in your splendor and majesty. Forgive us for failing to speak your glory to a world that is trapped in their small self-glory. Forgive us for not lifting each other up to be all that you have made us to be. We fear in times of trouble, we fail to trust you in times of opportunity, and we have forsaken your truth.

Leader: What is the work of creation?

All: The work of creation is, God's making all things of nothing, by the word of his power [a], in the space of six days, and all very good. [b]

Leader: How did God create man?

All: God created man male and female, after his own image [a], in knowledge [b], righteousness, and holiness [c], with dominion over the creatures [d].

[a]. Gen. 1:27 [b]. Col. 3:10 [c]. Eph. 4:24 [d]. Gen. 1:28; see Ps. 8

Leader: What are God's works of providence?

All: God's works of providence are, his most holy [a], wise [b], and powerful [c] preserving [d] and governing [e] all his creatures, and all their actions [f].

Leader: What special act of providence did God exercise toward man in the estate wherein he was created?

All: When God had created man, he entered into a covenant of life with him, upon condition of perfect obedience; forbidding him to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, upon pain of death. [a]
